6. Executive Director's Report

Heather Van Poucker reviewed the Public Housing operational reports for the month including pest control, occupancy, delinquencies, work orders and lease violations/warnings. FHC will undertake a wait list purge in August. Once purged, vacancies can be filled more efficiently and a date on when to next open the list can better be determined. There is currently a three to four year waiting list. The aim is to limit the wait list to 2 years. The Resident Survey has been completed and findings will be reported at the August meeting.

Van Poucker discussed purchases made including an insurance claim at Autumn House for water damage and parking lot resealing at both buildings ("micro purchase" that does not require prior board approval). FHC continues to wait on quotes to replace the 'mini split' air conditioning units at Autumn House/community room and the 'packaged terminal' air conditioning units at Withington Community Room. FHC has begun utilizing McCright for HCV inspection services.

Heather Van Poucker and Dan Martin attended the July 11, 2022, City Council meeting to present FHC property repositioning and recapitalization plans. They met with resident groups at both buildings and discussed the project and presented information about how it will proceed.

Another homeownership workshop with CHN is being planned for September. Van Poucker had an introductory conversation with a representative of Southwest Solutions about potential development projects they hope to undertake in Ferndale/Oak Park/Hazel Park.
