Review of Admissions and Continued Occupancy Policy Chapter 9 (NEW POLICY)

Emily Tong presented a change in HUD policy regarding PH families with incomes exceeding the over income limit for a total of 24 consecutive months. Tong stated that it may relate to a few FHC scattered site households and should not affect anyone in FHC buildings. After 24 months and a third notification and with an opportunity for a grievance hearing if the family's income exceeds the over income limit, the PHA must terminate tenancy withing 6 months of the third notice. If this should occur, FHC would assist the family with a transferring plan. Board members discuss PHA policy regarding termination of those families who would be affected by these changes by HUD. FHC Board members plan to review the decision after 18 months of this meeting.
